



IELTS Writing Task 1: Transferring graphic information to a short summary (150 words)



The bar charts collate qualitatively the relationship between the motives for higher education of an employees and the amount of support they gained from employers, which was heavily dependent on the age of employees. On the whole, we may observe that the younger the employees, the more the support they can get from employers.

First off, most younger adults under aged 26 (80%) pursued further studies for better career prospects ~~instanced at nearly 80%~~, and though the trend declined to nearly 70% for people aged ~~group~~ 26-29, ultimately ~~some~~ only 58% of this younger group pursued higher education for better job prospects.

In contrast, most middle-aged people continued studying for personal aspiration, considerably rising from 25% among the age group of 30-39 to nearly 70 % of people aged over 49. Interestingly, the motivation of continued education for better career progression and interest reached the watershed ~~moment occurring~~ in the age group of 40-49 when the juxtaposed trends achieved momentary equilibrium, evidenced at 40%.

In addition, ~~beginning at~~ 61% of employers provided support such as time off and study subsidy to younger employees who studied for career prospects, subsequently only 30% of employers ~~are~~ were willing to support the middle-aged employees. The trend rose to some 42% supporting employees aged over 49 for personal aspiration.

In sum, the data reveals the inclination of the employers to support younger employees rather than to middle-aged employees for personal aspiration to continued education. ~~benefits~~.
